INFORMATION PERTAINING TO THIS SCHOOL

Directions:

From Bendemeer or Uralla via the New England Highway

- 11 kms from Uralla turn left signposted Kentucky or; 36 kms from Bendemeer turn right - 4 kms to Kentucky village cross railway line and turn right on sealed road - 300 m turn left signposted Walcha and Terrible Vale Rd - 5 kms turn right over grid at letterboxes and signposted “Terrible Vale”. Follow the sealed road the whole way, 2 kms following signposts to The Hill and Ural (stay left on un-signposted roads)

From Walcha or Uralla via Thunderbolts Way

- 23 kms from Walcha turn left signposted Terrible Vale Rd or; 18 kms from Uralla turn right - 5 kms then over a low level creek crossing - 100 m and turn left over grid at letterboxes and signposted “Terrible Vale”. Follow the sealed road the whole way, 2 kms following signposts to The Hill and Ural (stay left on un-signposted roads)

Please meet us and park in front of the wool shed.

Total distance from - Armidale 42 km, Uralla 22 km, Walcha 31 km, Tamworth 88 km
