<p>Directions:</p> <p>Drive out of Blackall towards Tambo for 34 km. You will see the mailbox on the right-hand side of the highway, it's a big white box with an old saw blade on top.</p> <p>Dive straight ahead and follow the most used road, after about 800 m - 1 km you'll see a Grid on the right with Yellow on the bottom. Go across that and across the bridge and then continue up the road for about a kilometre to the house. Yards are to your right.</p> <p>If you're coming from Tambo, drive for approx. 65 km out of Tambo, crossing the Barcoo River. You will see the mailbox on the southern side of the highway (on the left) it's a big white box with an old saw blade on top.</p>
